

### BUTTER PRICE IS DOWN TO NORMAL

Butter is as cheap today as it was six years ago at this time. The same price ruled at this time in 1916 as it does today, indicating that the dairy industry has come back to normal. In fact, it may be that butter will show a further price loss here within the next few days unless there is a radical change in the present situation. This would put the price even below normal for this period of the year.

Consumers here are not likely to taste the New Zealand stock because of the present low price. Importers of the foreign butter, facing the extreme low prices here, are sending the foreign stock to more favorable markets.

Onions are quoted at 8c a pound on the Public Market and quality is not the best. While the Market Master quotes 8c as the price for No. 1 onions, No. 2 stock and even No. 3 stock is being sold in the stalls there without hindrance from the official whose duty it is to protect the public.

Eggs are quoted down to 32c a dozen on the public market, a drop of 4c a dozen since Thursday. Private stores are asking from 35c to 38c. This is for best stock. Pulllets are 3 to 3c cheaper. Fancy celery from California is now arriving and is selling at 15 and 20c a bunch generally.

While a small supply of Newport halibut is available at 30c a pound in the retail shops, fresh fish generally is scarce. This is especially true of fresh salmon. Storage quality even better than the fresh salmon now being offered.


