

EGGS ARE LOWEST FOR MANY YEARS

Egg prices are now dropping at such a lively rate that values are likely to go far below the point where supply and demand meet. An advance would there-

fore be forced which would be unreasonable.
Just now eggs are obtainable at prices that are fully as low as normal during the so-called "flush production" period. Since the advent of commercial poultry concerns in this territory the laying season has been considerably advanced into the winter months. This accounts for the fact that today eggs are so plentiful that it is impossible to keep supplies cleaned up even at lower prices.
At prevailing values eggs are far cheaper than meats or fish. Naturally this is causing concern to butchers and fish dealers, but consumers buy that

which they can secure cheapest.
Consumers should not worry over the quality of the eggs now on the market. There is no little cold storage stock available that it has ceased to be a market factor. Retailers are no longer buying cold storage stock.
