

Sanford Whiting Accused of Plan to 'Wean' His Son

Mrs. Iva Whiting, former wife of Dr. Sanford Whiting, charged before Circuit Judge Tucker Thursday afternoon, that though her oldest son, Curtis, was legally in her custody, her former husband and his present wife were trying to "wean" the boy away from her with promises of a big automobile and a fine home in Irvington.

The charges were made during the hearing on a motion by Dr. Whiting that the alimony for his former wife be reduced from \$185 to \$100 a month and that he be given the custody of Curtis.

Mrs. Iva Whiting said that since December, 1920, Curtis had been living most of the time with Dr. Whiting, but that he returned a week ago and said he was unable to stand the treatment of his stepmother and father any longer.

SAYS INCOME HIT
Judge Tucker declared at the conclusion of the hearing that before taking any action on the custody of the children or the alimony he wanted to have a private talk with both children. He ordered that they be taken to his office Saturday morning.

Dr. Whiting testified that since 1916, when his domestic troubles began, his income had dropped from \$20,000 to about \$9000 a year. He said because of his office expenses and the expenses of his own home he was unable to pay more than \$100 a month alimony.

Dr. Whiting said at his first wife was divorced in 1916 and he later married Mrs. Mary Morgan, divorced wife of a Portland capitalist. Mrs. Whiting No. 1 brought a \$50,000 suit for alienation of affections.

SETTLED FOR \$2000
It was brought out for the first time Thursday that this case was settled by a \$2000 cash payment. Mrs. Whiting No. 1 spent \$1300 of this in making a trip to Europe to study social welfare work, she testified.

When the divorce was granted Mrs. Whiting says she was given a lump sum of \$5000 alimony and \$125 a month. The monthly payment was recently increased by Circuit Judge Tucker to \$185 a month. Mrs. Whiting said the \$5000 had been invested and that she was keeping the money for her son.

Internal Revenue Office Should Be Free of 'Politics'

Washington, Jan. 14.—(WASHINGTON BUREAU OF THE JOURNAL).—The civil service commission believes that political bias should be removed from the office of internal revenue collectors. This is one of the remaining strongholds of the spoils system, with more than 4000 deputy collectors on the roster.

"There is no reason why a collector and his force who perform efficient services should not be retained as a part of the business organs of the government," says the annual report of the civil service commission, "for the internal revenue service performs one of the most important of the purely business functions. So long as the present method continues, appointments will be based more largely on political affiliations than on merit and efficiency, and there will be no incentive to industry and efficiency, since tenure will depend upon continuance of the party in power."

"Under the present system a much larger sum is necessary for salaries than an experienced force would require, and an immense sum is lost through failure to collect revenues which an experienced force would collect."

It is explained that the turnover in the customs service is very small as compared with the internal revenue service because of the application of the merit system to all positions below the office of collector.

Homer Davenport Memorial Indorsed By Senator McNary

Washington, Jan. 14.—(WASHINGTON BUREAU OF THE JOURNAL).—Senator McNary has issued the following statement indorsing the movement for erection of a memorial to the late Homer Davenport, near Silverton, Or.:

He was one of the pioneers of caricature and did much to develop the art now so commonly employed in all our magazines. Few cartoonists have reached the eminence that was attained by Mr. Davenport and fewer have died leaving a greater circle of friends and admirers."
