

BUTTER AND EGGS ARE FORCED HIGHER

Eggs and butter continue to advance and consumers are called upon to make their reasonable contribution because of weather conditions. Recently the lay of eggs has been cut so severely that arrivals at Portland have been alarmingly small. Despite this fact, eggs are today cheaper on the public market than at wholesale, providing any producer is foolish enough to sell there. Practically no eggs have recently been offered on the market because of this. Instead of the market master adding the public by quoting the low price of eggs, such low quotation has had the effect of forcing the public to pay a still greater sum because none are available on the market and the private stores must be rationed if eggs are wanted.

Butter prices are 3c a pound higher at retail shops because of an advance of that sum at wholesale. Prices on the public market should not be confused with prices in the retail shops. Public market prices are for dairy butter, which sells not over 25c a pound at wholesale, while the regular stores quote specialty butter, which sells at 35c a pound wholesale.
