

LAST RITES FOR POPE BEING HELD BY CHURCH HEADS

The pope's body from the Vatican throne room to St. Peter's began.
Outside the Vatican great crowds had gathered, for the word had spread that the removal was to take place early today instead of 4 o'clock as originally planned.

procession formed in one of the large halls of the Vatican, headed by a detachment of the noble guards. After the guards came Cardinal Gasparri, Cardinal Camerlengo and the dean. CHOIR SINGS
Monsignor Respighi, papal master of ceremonies, gave the signal for the procession to start shortly before 9 o'clock. It was led by the sacred college, the choir and the pope's bier.

At St. Peter's
An escort of Swiss guards formed about the bier and the order of formation of the procession was reversed, so that the bier was in the front. The procession entered the basilica at 9:10. The bier was carried to the altar and placed on a catafalque. The choir sang a requiem mass, and the pope's body was placed in a lead casket.

There being no response, the cardinal turned and said: "The pope is verily dead."
The sacred college held the first of its daily sessions this morning. These sessions will continue until after the funeral of the pope and up to February 2 when the conclave for election of a new pope will be held.

FRANCE SORROWS FOR POPE
PARIS, Jan. 23.—The papal nuncio at Paris has been accepted the condolences of President Millerand and Premier Poincaré. The pope's death was a great sorrow to the French people.

At the same time the dactyl from the Vatican state chancery brought the seals with which Pope Benedict had authenticated his papal bulls and briefs. The seals and keys were broken in the presence of the cardinal chamberlain during the last days of the pope's illness.
