

STRAINED HONEY QUITE REASONABLE

Consumers have been neglecting honey this season because the price of comb stock has been high. They do not realize that because comb stock is extremely high that bargains are available in other offerings. For instance, strained honey is selling reasonably low at this time and excellent quality is available.

Consumers appear to fear adulteration of strained honey but the pure food law makes it difficult for the adulterator to get away with it. You can buy strained honey without fear.

California vegetables have all but taken the local markets because of recent freezing weather. Even the southern stock is not plentiful because of the cold snap there. Mexican tomatoes are available in fair supply and at reasonable prices and there are excellent quality offerings of celery.

Fresh fish continues scarce but some of the downtown markets still are offering limited stocks of fresh salmon and halibut at 30 cents a pound. Very good fresh crabs are now available at former prices, but there are no razor clams. Some hardshells are offering.

Oregon Official Establishes Speed Record in Wyoming

Wyoming speed records were broken by an Oregon official on duty in that state, according to the comment of the editor of the Rawlins Republican, in a copy which just reached Portland.

After making a drive of 170 miles from Green River Tuesday, riding the midnight train to Rawlins that night and then starting out in a snow storm Wednesday morning to make an examination of several oil camps in the Ferris Field, A. E. Gebhardt, examiner for the corporation commission in Oregon, made a record for a public official which taxpayers would welcome in any state.
