

15,000 LOSE ALL THEIR SAVINGS IN POZIE-LIKE DEAL

Chicago, Feb. 13.—Lincoln's birthday, 1922, will be remembered by at least 15,000 Lithuanians and Poles in the "back of the yard" district here as a day when roseate dreams of quick riches turned to dismal realization that hard-ship and even starvation is just ahead.

Throughout the district Sunday showed the mournful "Oye, oye, oye" of Slav-ian women, wailing and weeping when death strikes their homes. In the tumble-down tenements laboring men sat sullenly. At the Lithuanian church even the priest was tearful for he too has lost his savings, swept away and he is also suffering the additional humiliation of having encouraged his followers to invest in the Bischoff enterprises.

Even the neighborhood savings banks have been heavily hit. In fact, the district small merchants have lost practically because their customers have lost all their savings, according to Streykman.

Dischoff's manipulations, according to federal authorities, were exactly those of Ponzi. A mere youth himself, he is alleged to have been a member of the out-Ponzied the hitherto most shrewd example of frenzied finance.

Good looking, with a winning personality, and shrewdly calculating, Dischoff, two years ago after a term in prison for desertion from the army, and in that time acquired a magnificent home, a summer home in Michigan, and became the financial patron saint of the foreign element in the stock yards district.

Like Ponzi, he offered from 40 to 100 per cent profit on 60 and 90-day notes. He paid the early notes and the news of the wonderful profits spread through the district like wildfire.

JAIL HIS REFUGUE
When he was thrown into bankruptcy and the Central Trust company appointed receiver, he begged to be kept in custody.

"I never want to go back to the west side," he said in his last interview with \$4,500,000 and the receivers declare this sum will reach \$7,000,000.

There are 4000 creditors, and their claims are being examined by Streykman said. "Besides these people who have sold their homes, given over their savings and even their weekly pay envelopes to him, thousands of merchants in the district are facing dire times. Most of these poor people have been out of work much of the time in the last year, and every cent they could was handed over to Dischoff.

Woman Shocks Man And Breaks Hip in Fall From Window

Miss Morton, leaning from a window in the Klatsko theatre building late Saturday night, fell here at 10 o'clock, falling through a glass canopy and falling directly on the head of West, one of a number of pedestrians passing.

West, who was thrown violently to the sidewalk, sustained only lacerations and bruises of a minor nature, while Miss Morton, according to witnesses, escaped almost certain death through his unwritten intervention.
