

RISH FACTORS AGREE TO GO TO LONDON TO MEET

London, March 27.—(U. P.)—The house of lords today passed the Irish bill on its third reading, without a record vote. This constitutes ratification of the Irish-British treaty.

Belfast, March 27.—(L. N. S.)—While news was arriving today of fresh outbreaks and violent death, the Ulster cabinet met and accepted on behalf of Premier Sir James Craig the invitation to go to London to a peace party.

The decision of the Ulster cabinet assures that the peace council will be held in London under the patronage of the British government.

Michael Collins, minister of finance in the Irish provisional government at Dublin, already had accepted a similar invitation.

Mr. James will go to London tomorrow and the pacification meeting is expected to open on Wednesday.

The British government will exert strong pressure upon both the Irish Free states and the Ulsterites to compel them to settle their differences and restore peace along the Ulster frontier, where guerrilla warfare is now in full swing.

Eleven deaths have been reported in Belfast and elsewhere in Ulster since Sunday morning.

Four deaths were reported from Caledonia County, Tyrone. The victims had all fallen in border fighting.

Terror reigned throughout the night in this city with rifle and pistol volleys being heard in the streets.

Dr. Sun Plotting to Be President of All China, Report Says

Shanghai, March 27.—It is reported unofficially in the Chinese press today that a treaty has been concluded between Dr. Sun Yat Sen, president of the Southern Chinese republic and General Chang Tso Lin, war lord of Manchuria and one of the most powerful independent figures in China.

According to the press, the objects of the treaty are three fold: First—Overthrow of the Peking government.

Second—Defeat of Wu Pei Fu.

Third—Installation of Sun Yat Sen as president.

Following installed as president, if the new alliance attains its objects, Dr. Sun, according to the stories published, is to go on an extended tour of foreign capitals in the interests of China.

Dr. Sun, at the head of the armies of the South marching north against Wu Pei Fu, has reached Changsha, in Hunan province.
