

SIDETRACK FACES SMITH - M'NARY LAND MEASURE

Majority Leader Mondell Serves Notice Land Bill Will Have to Wait a More Favorable Day.

(By Universal Service)
Washington, May 20.—Republican house leaders have virtually agreed not to act on the Smith-McNary land reclamation and settlement bill this session of congress.
Majority leader Mondell has served notice on the Western group that he has been active in support of the measure that the bill will have to wait a more favorable day.
"Our attitude without regard to the merits of the measure, is that we cannot take up at this session either projects involving large additional expenditures or new measures of any sort. Our whole program is to keep down our expenditures and embark on nothing new," said Mondell.

LAND SETTLEMENT
Mr. Mondell contends that the land settlement provision of the soldier bonus bill is subject to whatever revision proponents of the Smith-McNary bill may desire, will serve the same general purpose at this time. He is the author of the land reclamation and settlement bill, and also the only western member of the Republican steering committee which will decide the fate of the bill.
"The veterans from the very beginning have favored the land reclamation or land settlement legislation as part of the bonus bill," continued Mondell. "It was the first provision of the original, four-fold plan presented to congress by the soldier organizations. It has been in both bonus bills as they passed the house and there will be no trouble on the retaining it in the present bonus bill if those who favor this legislation will make themselves active in its support."

SMITH KEEPS HEART
If the section as it now stands does not suit, there is no reason why it should not be modified by the senate and the difference adjusted when the bill goes to conference.
Representative Addison T. Smith of Oregon said today that he had "not lost heart" over the present attitude of the Republican steering committee towards the bill which has the indorsement of President Harding and Secretary of the Interior Fall. He said:
"The men in congress who have made the fight for this legislation will not give up now. We are going to hold a meeting within the next two or three days and organize for a final drive. It must not be forgotten that a dozen Western states elect United States senators this fall."

Children Play on Boat; One Drowns, One Life Is Saved

Toledo, Or., May 20.—Wretha Small, 12-year-old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Small, was drowned here today while playing with her cousin from Elk City. The two children were romping about a boat and both fell into the bay. A third little girl, who was with the playmates and saw the accident, ran and hid. The Small child sank at once, but her cousin remained on the surface and was rescued by men who were passing down the river.
The child who was saved told her rescuers of her companion's fate and still in the water. The body of the missing child was recovered a half hour later. The life saving station at Newport was notified, but efforts made to revive the child with a pumpster were unsuccessful.

Husband Kills Self After Attempting To Murder His Wife

Walla Walla, Wash., May 20.—George Scroggie, about 30 years old, is dead, with a bullet hole through his heart, and his wife is in a local hospital with body wounds which are expected to prove fatal, as a result of a family quarrel at the Scroggie home here Saturday morning.
Neighbors were made aware of trouble between the two when Mrs. Scroggie ran out of her apartment and across the hall to an apartment occupied by another family. Scroggie followed her, shot her twice and then turned the weapon on himself, according to the report to the police. Scroggie died instantly and his wife is now undergoing an operation, which surgeons hope will save her life.
Mrs. Scroggie is said to have relatives named Ingram in Lewiston, Idaho. They have been notified by Coroner Joe Chamberlain.

Tchitcherin Quotes Bible in Explaining Russia's Position

Genoa, May 20.—(U. S. S.)—"Do you remember the story in the Bible of Satan taking Christ up on the top of a mountain and offering the riches of the world if he would do Satan's bidding?" George Tchitcherin, soviet commissioner for foreign affairs, queried today when seen by an International News Service correspondent.
"Soviet Russia has stood on the mountain at Genoa and has been offered all the desires of the world if she will only surrender the fundamental principles upon which her state has been built," he continued.
"I don't mean to compare ourselves with Christ, poor the allies with the devil, but the same principle of temptation we spurned," he added with a significant shrug of the shoulders.
Dead tired from the arduous conference labors, he begged to be excused from further discussion of the results of the party. Regarding the meeting at The Hague, he would say nothing except:
"I am hopeful."
