

## MEN FREQUENTLY CALLED ON WARD, EMPLOYEES SAY

White Plains, N. Y., June 1.—(I. N. S.)—"Charlie" Ross and "Jack," companions of Clarence Peters, the former of whom was killed by Walter S. Ward, millionaire vice president of the Ward Baking company, were frequent visitors at Ward's office, according to a statement made this afternoon by one of the Ward office employees.

According to this employee, the two men who, according to Ward, were conspiring with Peters in an effort to blackmail him out of \$100,000, had ready access to Ward's private office. Their visits usually lasted from 10 minutes to half an hour.

Sensational developments tending to discredit the story of Ward are expected soon. It was revealed today by a Westchester county official who is active in the investigation of the crime and its motive.

If these developments turn out according to present expectations, the official declared that young Ward would be rearrested on a murder charge. At present he is at liberty on \$50,000 bail with only the charge of manslaughter hanging over him.

The Westchester county authorities

are bending all their energies to running down the report that Peters, instead of being shot to death upon the Kensico reservoir road while he and two companions were demanding \$75,000 blackmail from the young millionaire, were really killed in the library of Ward's luxurious home at New Rochelle.

## Sleeping Husband Is Mutilated With Scissors by Wife

Los Angeles, June 1.—(I. N. S.)—Fearing that another woman might win his love and inspired by jealousy, Mrs. Ethel Nolan, 24, a bay merchant, with a pair of scissors as he lay asleep in his home early today and mutilated his body. The wife was taken into custody on a charge of mayhem.

Mrs. Nolan, the mother of five children, made a statement to the police following her husband's removal to the receiving hospital. In it she professed her love for him and declared:

"I don't know why I did it; I love him dearly and wanted him for myself; I fear he was untrue to me, and in my mad frenzy I committed the awful deed. I am so sorry—I didn't realize what I was doing."

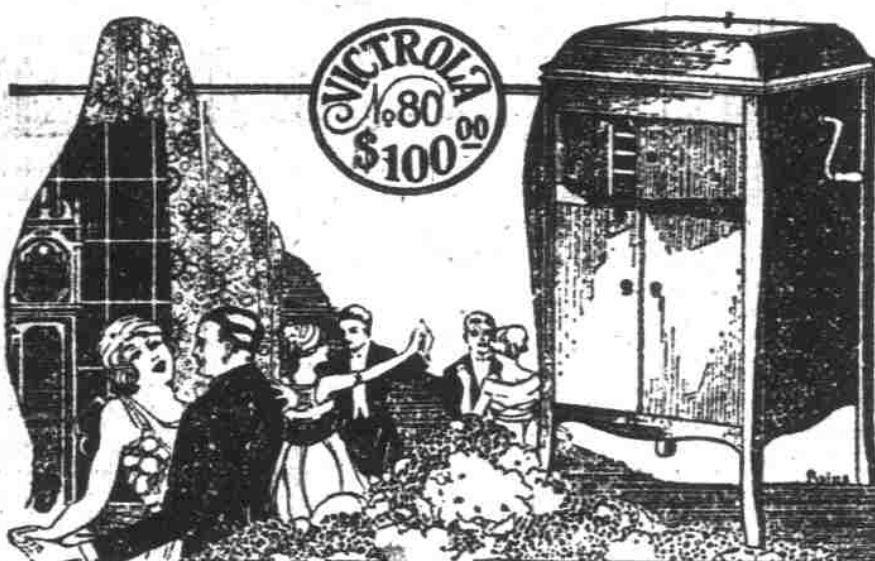
Nolan was treated at the receiving hospital and his condition was regarded as serious.
