Harvard States Students' Body Will Be Reduced

Cambridge, Mass., June 6.—Qualifications for admission to Harvard university are to be so readjusted that the number of students matriculating each year will be materially reduced.

Ignoring the widespread report, based on previous announcements from the faculty that the number of Jewish students at Cambridge will be restricted, the board of overseers has announced the appointment of a committee to consider ways and means whereby there will be "more effective sifting of candidates for admission."

The board met in special session Monday to consider the overworked conditions and presumably to discuss the protests that previous hints of such a restriction have aroused. At the conclusion of the meeting it was officially announced that:

"The board of overseers passed the following vote at their meeting today: Voted, that a committee be drawn from the faculty of the university and appointed by the president of the university to consider and report to the governing board principles and methods for more effective sifting of candidates for admission to the university of which the committee authorized by the faculty of arts and sciences shall be a part."

"The vote of the faculty of arts and sciences was in similar terms. No further action will be taken or any change made in the existing entrance requirements until the committee has reported."
