WEATHER CONDITIONS

High pressure prevails from Oklahoma and Kansas eastward. The weather is generally clear and pleasant, with a moderate breeze from the west. The pressure is moderately low, the lowest reading being in Astoria. Precipitation has occurred in the northern Rock Mountain region and in the Gila States and Tennessee. The heaviest rainfall reported was 2.52 inches at Galveston, Texas. Freezing weather continues in Northern Alberta and in the northwestern part of Canada. In the south, west, and north, the temperature is in the upper Mississippi valley, the upper Lake region, the north Atlantic states, and Northern Utah.
Relative humidity at Portland: Noon yesterday, 49 per cent; 5 p. m. yesterday, 49 per cent; 5 a. m. today, 76 per cent.
Precipitation since January 1, Total, 17.74 inches; normal, 23.24 inches; deficiency, 5.50 inches.
