**How is the Road?**

Oregon state highway commission weekly report on condition of 147 main highways and 125 branch roads.

**PACIFIC HIGHWAY**  
Portland-Oregon City—Fair. Concrete bridge at Oregon City closed for construction; traffic from Portland to Oregon City and Milwaukie on 52d street, both of which are paved through Oregon City and Milwaukie. Lines should take west side route, which is paved to Molokini and crosses from there to West Lane.

Oregon City-Cambria—Faded.

Salmon-Jefferson-Albany—Faded.

Albany-Corvallis-Junction City-Eugene—Gravel from Albany to Corvallis; pavement to Eugene.

Eugene-Drain—Paved most of the way; short detour around new concrete pavement south of Geashes; turn left on Cloverdale road for about 1500 feet, then south along a lane about 1000 feet, returning to highway about three-fourths of a mile south of Geashes; two short detours are necessary at Camas Swale, balance of highway to Drain is paved with the exception of a short section at Oak tags Grove.

Grain-Houseburg—Highway open and paved or macadamized; detour from highway just south of Wilbur via Cascade Valley road; detour from Highway at Houseburg; first 5 miles are narrow and require careful driving; return to highway at Houseburg; one-half mile north of Houseburg; concrete paving operations now going on here; detour limits will not be open after working hours.

Myrtle Creek-Carrollville—Construction under way; traffic detoured via Middle during working hours (7 A. M. to 5 P. M.); detour except Highway detour rough on south end.

Laytonville-Galena—Good macadam; traffic cautioned to look out for construction crews.

Galena-Vegeta Creek—Faded.

Grave Creek-Section 3 (Smith Hill)—Good macadam from Grave Creek to summit of section mountains; construction under way; detour around road to south of mountain; traffic detoured over road to south of mountain; Section 3-Grain-Pass—Faded.

Grain Pass-Medford-Bland-Columbia State Lane—Faded.

**WEST SIDE HIGHWAY**  
Portland-West. Traffic for traffic for McLinnville and points beyond will find an alternate route via Weston. Three miles; highway closed for construction from Lafayette to Mt. St. Joseph-McIntyre—Faded.

McIntyre-Whitson—Closed for paving; traffic for Whitson and points south take Booth-Head road, leaving McLinnville via Great street, widening highway at Whitson.

Whitson-Amiti—New highway closed; take old road, gravelled and in fair condition.

Amiti-Holmes—Closed except three-fourths mile near Holmes Gap, which is gravelled.

Holmes Gap-Rickard—Gravelled and in fair condition; rough and rutted in places, but all safely passable.

Rickard-Monmouth-Independence—Faded.

Independence-Corvallis—Take road via River; gravelled to Benton county line; paved county line to Corvallis.

Corvallis-Junction City-Eugene—Faded.

**COLUMBIA RIVER HIGHWAY**  
Portland-Astoria—Faded, except one mile through Rainier.

Portland-Cascade Locks-Hood River-Mosier—Faded.

Mosier-The Dalles—Paved, except two miles of macadam; contractor has paving between Mosier and Rowena, so that travel will be compelled to adhere to the following schedule in passing over the new pavement. Hood is closed 7:15 A. M. to 12:30 P. M. M. is open after 4 P. M.; this schedule will remain in force until June, when a short detour will be provided around paving operations at all hours for light traffic only; detour is steep and narrow; detour over Seven Mile hill is also open at all hours and is in fair condition; east-bound traffic detour via Weston; west-bound traffic will detour at Mosier, and westbound traffic will detour
