WEATHER FORECAST

Portland and vicinity—Tonight and Sunday fair, northern winds, light to moderate. Oregon and Washington—Tonight and Sunday fair, moderate northerly winds.

WEATHER CONDITIONS

Low pressure over the Lake region and the extreme northern Rocky mountain region, over the central and southern Rocky mountain region is the rule, the highest reading being in Alaska and British Columbia. Local precipitation has occurred at various points in the Pacific Northwest, the heaviest report having been 2.24 inches at Astoria, 1.5 inches at Portland. Temperature changes have been mostly unimportant and the seasonable temperature prevails over the greater part of the country. Relative humidity at Portland: Noon yesterday, 46 per cent; 3 p. m. yesterday, 33 per cent; 5 a. m. today, 43 per cent. Precipitation since January 1. Total, 17.85 inches; normal, 23.5 inches; deficiency, 5.65 inches.
