

### RAIL UNMERGER ISSUE BUSINESS MEN'S PROBLEM

Issues involved in the Central Pacific-Southern Pacific controversy are of such tremendous importance to Oregon and Portland that it would be advantageous to have all the facts placed before the business interests of the state and then let the decision come as to Oregon's stand after a fair time had been given for consideration.

This was the attitude expressed by the special railway committee of the Chamber of Commerce following its meeting Tuesday afternoon with William Sproule, president of the Southern Pacific company. Those in attendance at the meeting were: H. B. VanDuser, chairman; Nathan Strauss, L. Allen Lewis, Emory Oimsted, Ira P. Powers, F. A. Nitchy and George Lawrence Jr. Sproule reiterated to the committee the desire that Portland and Oregon align themselves with the Southern Pacific. The committee has been hearing the viewpoints of both railroads and announced that it had formed no conclusion as to procedure and that there could be no suggestion from any source that there was a division of opinion because no effort has yet been made by the committee or its members to decide the case until all facts had been presented and considered fully.

### Shortage of Labor Curtails Output of The Dalles Plant

The Dalles, June 21.—Because of a shortage in cannery labor in The Dalles, fruit that might be handled here must be shipped to the plant at Yakima and other points, it was learned Tuesday when announcement was made that reduced rates on haulage of fruit between Hood River and The Dalles and points in Idaho to Yakima, Wash., had been established. The new rate on cherries, loganberries, strawberries and a few other perishable items is 30 cents a cental, with minimum of 20,000 pounds, in straight or mixed car lots. A new rate of 42½ cents per cental on cherries, with a minimum of 20,000 pounds from Lewiston, Idaho, to Yakima, was also granted. This means that the Libby, McNeill & Libby company and other canners can buy fruit at outside points and ship to the canneries that are able to handle it. No Wasco county fruit will be shipped to Yakima, but none from outside points will be shipped here for canning. Some carload lots of strawberries already have been shipped from Hood River to Yakima for canning.

### Receive Plans for Winchester Bridge To Cost \$250,000

Roseburg, June 21.—Plans for the new highway bridge at Winchester, north of Roseburg, were laid before the county court Tuesday. The bridge is to be one of the largest and most attractive in the state. It is to be more than a quarter of a mile long and will have seven concrete arches, the spans being 125 feet in length. One approach will be 82 feet long and the other 81.

The bridge will be below the site of the present one and will parallel the railroad bridge at that point, cutting off a bad bit of highway. The highway commission is now advertising for bids and the contract probably will be let this month. Local engineers estimate the cost at \$250,000.

### S. Bolton Named For Postmaster

Washington, June 21.—(WASHINGTON BUREAU OF THE JOURNAL)—Simeon Bolton, the first eligible, was nominated Tuesday by President Harding as postmaster at The Dalles, Or. The postoffice department notified Representative Sinnott that rural route No. 1 out of Tualuma will be operated six days instead of three days a week, beginning July 1.
