

VERDICT GIVEN IN COOS COUNTY FEE ACTION FOR WEST

Eugene, June 21.—Ex-Governor Oswald West won his suit against Coos county here late yesterday afternoon, the jury quickly returning a verdict for the amount asked. Coos county attorneys stated that the case will be appealed to the supreme court. If the appeal fails, West will be able to collect from Douglas county a large sum, in addition to what he will receive from Coos county. The amount sued for was \$19,681.4 per cent on \$490,000 tax and timber sale money on the Southern Oregon land grant, refunded to Coos county by the government in 1919, and represents West's fee for lobbying at the national capital to secure the passage of the refunding bill.

West claims that he had an oral contract with County Judge Watson of Coos county to go to Washington in the interests of the bill and that this agreement was ratified by the county court. An agreement, West claims, between the Coos and Douglas county courts fixed his compensation at 4 per cent of the amount received from the federal government. Judge Watson and Commissioner Phillips of Coos county were afterwards recalled on account of their agreement with West.

The case was tried here before Judge H. H. Belt of Dallas. Coos county was represented by Goss, Kendall & Murphy and Ben S. Fisher, district attorney of that county. West was represented by Dey, Hampson & Nelson of Portland.

Pint of Moonshine Brings \$100 Fine

Conviction in municipal court Tuesday of Joseph Mielke, proprietor of a rooming house at First and Main streets, of possession of a pint of moonshine whiskey cost him \$100 in fines. Mielke is said by the police to be an old offender. S. Pihl, public

market vendor, was fined \$20 in municipal court on a charge of selling decayed strawberries. According to the police, Pihl sold boxes in which the top layers of berries were good but those underneath were spoiled.

Large Share of Cherry Crop Is Sold to Packer

The Dalles, June 21.—Approximately two-thirds of the Wasco county cherry crop to be marketed through the Oregon Growers' Cooperative association pool this year will be sold direct to the Libby, McNeill & Libby company plant, according to announcement made Tuesday by C. R. Thompson, local manager for the growers.

The cannery here has contracted for the cherries at 3 1/2 cents a pound and Thompson said he did not believe that the cooperatives would ship more than five carloads of Royal Anns this year. The shipment of Royal Anns from The Dalles was attempted for the first time last year on a large scale and the results were not as good as they were expected to be.

Practically all of the black cherries, the Bing and the Lambert, will be shipped as usual, practically all the local production has been contracted for at good prices, prices of from 3 1/2 to 10 cents a pound being paid.

Picking conditions so far have been excellent and the fruit is ripening so rapidly that difficulty in obtaining enough workers is being experienced.

Wasco Republicans Name Party Chiefs

The Dalles, June 21.—Resolutions endorsing the present administration and suggesting a modification of the present primary laws were passed by the Republican county central committee in session here Tuesday afternoon. Organization for the year took place, with the result that W. L. Crichton, county clerk, was elected chairman; T. A. Siamis Jr., secretary; J. M. Patterson, treasurer; A. E. Crosby, state committeeman, and George D. Brodie, district committeeman.

selected school board director here Monday without a dissenting vote being cast. The election was devoid of interest for Kirk had no opposition and there were no write-ins. A total of 153 votes were cast. There were no issues on the ballot to be settled.
