

CHRISTIAN CHURCH LOOKS TO FUTURE WITH OPTIMISM

Turner, July 5.—Viewing the outlook for the church in the state of Oregon optimistically, the Rev. Elijah V. Stivers of Eugene, re-elected yesterday president of the state board for the fourth time in the business sessions of the convention of Christian churches being held here, said he fully expected this year to be the greatest in all departments.

"In particular," he said, "we wish to emphasize the part which we are desirous of having the laymen of the church take in the future sessions. We feel that the Oregon convention in one of the outstanding conventions of the West because of the permanence of our location at Turner."

The report of State Secretary C. F. Swander showed a total of \$14,000 raised, 16 missionaries employed and a considerable number of additions to Oregon churches. He reported that in 1922 the churches in Oregon would celebrate their diamond anniversary, as that year would mark the 75th annual meeting, and his recommendation that the intervening five years be spent in a diamond anniversary campaign, with an objective of \$75,000 for Oregon missions, to close with a diamond jubilee convention, met with hearty approval. The convention also approved the report of the future work committee, which recommended the adoption of the state secretary's report and particularly emphasized the cooperation of all the Oregon Christian churches in the simultaneous evangelistic campaign planned to begin November 25.

Traverse Harrison of Cincinnati was added to the staff of teachers in the Leadership Training school and will conduct classes for the young people's division. A. F. Henney, Congo missionary, told of the seven missionaries who have gone to Africa from Oregon after being trained in the Eugene Bible university. W. F. Turner of Spokane, Northwest superintendent of missions, spoke.

Gets Final Papers After Having Full Rights 40 Years

Salem, July 5.—After having exercised the privileges of an American citizen for 40 years, William Wengroth, formerly a citizen of Germany, was granted his final citizenship papers by Circuit Judge Bingham here Monday.

Wengroth has served on juries, grand juries and election boards. A similar case was presented in the application of Christopher Arthur Hindson Fisher, who, however, failed to receive his final papers. Fisher, although not an American citizen, has served for four years as a justice of the peace and as a member of school boards.
