

AUTO TOURISTS GET BLAME FOR STARTING FIRES

Eatonville, Wash., July 21.—Judging from experience, firefighters have been having with some tourists, little doubt is left as to how many of the forest fires were started. Some tourists built a fire at an old mill site in a pile of sawdust, just south of Eatonville. When they left, they merely kicked some more sawdust over the fire. Within a few hours the fire had broken out and was spreading rapidly, and had it not been put out just when it was, it would have threatened the local water supply.

Some tourists had built a large fire just north of Alder. When a fire warden arrived on the scene, the fire was burning briskly and spreading. He ordered it put out. The tourists threatened all sorts of dire things. The warden calmly walked over and got their auto license numbers, and then pointed to a sign just a few feet away, which specifically forbade building fires there. Practically the same thing happened between Miners and Morton, except in the latter instance the fire was under a large cedar log, and children were shooting firecrackers in every direction. Here, also, there was a sign forbidding fires.

William Edlund was driving along the mountain road behind two of the auto busses operated by the Rainier National Park company. Within a very short distance he had to stop and put out two fires started from cigar stubs, one of which he saw thrown by a passenger in one of the busses.

On the other hand many are the accounts of tourists who are scrupulously careful with their fires.

FIRST FIRE REPORTED IN SANTIAM NATIONAL FOREST
Albany, Or., July 21.—Supervisor C. C. Hall of the Santiam forest, Thursday reported the first fire of the season in his territory. The blaze was reported a few miles above Detroit. It was under control Thursday night and was expected to be extinguished by Friday. The entire fire covered less than one fourth of an acre, and inflicted no damage.

Also near Detroit an 800 acre fire is reported to have been burning in state land, but to have caused little or no damage.

Shull Tells Why He Wants Offices In Girls' School

"My idea in using the present Girls' Polytechnic school building for administrative purposes, rather than the old Holladay school, was an economical rather than an expensive plan," commented Chairman Frank L. Shull this morning upon his opposition to other board members in adopting the Holladay administrative site.

"I did not intend that we should use the Girls' Polytechnic building, indefinitely, but only for such time as we could sell it," he continued. "We would be put to no expense whatever by so doing, whereas, it will cost us considerable money to repair the burned Holladay building and use it for administrative use."

"Not only is the Holladay site entirely outside the business section of the city, but we will be occupying an entire block which we do not need. We can secure cheap rentals in the city and need not be in an expensive building. We do not need to use an entire block in the residence portion of the city."

Eight Diphtheria Cases Are Reported In One Household

Eight cases of diphtheria in one family were reported to the city health office today by Dr. E. L. Booth, who said Mr. and Mrs. F. Morasco and their six children were suffering from mild cases at No. 24 East 29th street. Aid is being given by neighbors, although the father and mother are able mostly to attend to the others in the home. City Health Officer Parrish announced that if the cases should develop into malignant forms, the family would be sent to the isolation hospital.

Dr. Parrish was disturbed by reports of 15 cases of smallpox in the North Alberta and St. Johns districts. Rigid quarantine has been established and the doctor issued a warning that parents should be sure that their children are vaccinated before the reopening of school.
