

CORONER'S JURY CENSURES DOCTOR IN POISON CASE

Seattle, Aug. 4.—(U. P.)—Prosecuting Attorney Malcolm Douglas today was preparing to take action upon the verdict of a coroner's jury, in which censure for the accidental poisoning of Rev. S. Cameron Morrison, rector of the church of the Epiphany, Wednesday night, was laid upon Dr. C. P. Bryant, M. P. Dix, druggist, and the drug inspector.

After Douglas had been given the evidence in the case when the jury had finished its deliberations last night, he said, "Whether prosecution will be started in the case depended upon the classification of barium sulphide under the drug law, and largely upon the result of further investigation.

"The law states that certain poisons must be labeled and that all other poisons fatal to life in doses of 60 grains must be also labeled. We must determine the standing of barium sulphide before proceeding."

The jury's report stated "that we, the jury, desire to censure the druggist (Dr. P. Dix) for selling this drug without inquiring as to its use; to censure the physician (Dr. C. P. Bryant) for giving an oral instead of a written prescription in so dangerous a matter, and to censure the state drug inspector for carelessness."

The Rev. Mr. Morrison took the barium sulphide in the case of barium sulphate, which was to have been taken as a preparation for an X-ray examination. He died in the bathroom of his home a few minutes after swallowing the dose Wednesday evening.
