

PRICE OF FRESH FISH IS STEADY

Fresh fish are still plentiful, but no change is noticed in the prices. Salmon is still priced at 25c per pound, while silversides, smaller salmon, are around 12½c. Halibut, although more plentiful than it has been for the past week, is still 30c. A drop is expected in the price of the white fish soon. Sturgeon is still 25c per pound, while black cod is generally priced around 15c. The demand for poultry is keeping up well. Light hens are priced 22c per pound on the public market, while heavy hens (over 4 pounds), are bringing 25c. Fryers are 30c and broilers 35c per pound. Vegetables are in abundance on the market. General prices prevailing for cauliflower are 10½c per head, but the extra large heads are bringing 20c in most instances. Some small stuff is seen at as low as 5c per head, but the quality is not of the best. Corn is still rather plentiful, bantam corn generally going at 20c per dozen, and in some places 15c per dozen. Tomatoes

are disappearing slowly. Their time for this season is about up. Those remaining are going at 4c per pound. Celery is quite abundant. Smaller heads are selling as low as 5c each, while larger stuff is as high as 15c. Retail prices generally show: Butter—Fresh creamery, 50¢ @ 54¢. Eggs—Salmon, 12½¢ @ 15¢; white, 30¢; black cod, 10¢ @ 12½¢; sturgeon, 25¢; 1½ lb. cod, 8¢ @ 10¢; bunch, 20¢ @ 25¢. Potatoes—New, 1¢ @ 1½¢ per lb. Corn—New, 15¢ @ 20¢; bantam, 15¢ @ 20¢. Yamhill street prices: Carrots, 4¢ bunch; string beans, 5¢ lb.; 1½ lb. cabbages, 2¢ lb.; cauliflower, 5¢ lb.; lettuce, 5¢ @ 10¢; potatoes, 1½¢ lb.; celery, 8¢ @ 10¢ bunch; tomatoes, 4¢ lb. Corn—Green, 15¢ @ 20¢; bantam, 15¢ @ 20¢.
