

PLANS ARE BEING DRAWN FOR UNIT OF INCINERATOR

City Engineer Laurgaard is completing the specifications for the proposed new unit of the garbage reduction plant which is proposed to erect during the ensuing winter, so that it may be in readiness for use when the increased collections of garbage come on with the spring months.

The ordinance authorizing advertisements for bids will be submitted to the city council at its session next Wednesday by Commissioner Bigelow and bids will be opened about 30 days later. It is expected actual construction work may be started by the first of the new year.

The proposed unit will cost \$100,000 or more. Garbage crematory bonds were voted by the people several years ago, and it from this issue that funds will be obtained for building of the new unit. During the past season the garbage collections have been far in excess of the present plant's capacity and several tons of refuse had to be buried daily.

PIER TO URGE SUPPORT OF SPECIAL 3-MILL TAX

The Portland Municipal Service association will meet in the council chamber at 8 o'clock tonight when its special committee on the retirement pension system will make its report giving reasons for not pressing the movement to get the measure on place on the ballot at the forthcoming election.

The position of this committee was that placing this measure on the ballot might jeopardize the passage of the special 3-mill tax levy.

Commissioner Pier, in charge of the department of finance, will address the meeting, detailing the results about the 3-mill tax measure be defeated.

CITY HALL BRIEFS

Only one bid, that of the Jacobson-Jensen company, was received Wednesday for the construction of a sewer in Flanders street, from 76 feet west of 10th street to the Willamette river. The estimate of the city engineer on this work was \$30,140. The bid was for \$29,984.55.

The first death from diphtheria for several weeks was reported to the city health office Wednesday. This was the death Tuesday night of Mrs. B. F. Wilkerson, aged 48, at the isolation hospital. Her home was at East Ninth and Davis streets.

On the ground that the service rendered was of benefit to the public, the city council decided to pay to Robert Duncan \$150 from The Auditorium fund as a refund for rental paid for use of that building for public service recall meetings.

The city engineer's estimate was \$30,140. The City Treasurer Adams has issued a call for the presentation for redemption of St. Johns improvement bonds numbered 662 to 672, inclusive, dated December 12, 1913, and called for redemption December 12 next.

Monarch Lumber Plant Will Pass To New Ownership

Organization of the North Portland Lumber company of Seattle, with a capitalization of \$750,000, was announced today at Olympia. The incorporators are L. W. David, J. E. David and J. D. Egan of Seattle. The new company will take over the properties of the Monarch Lumber company, located just west of the Union meat company's plant on Columbia street at North Portland.

The Monarch mill has a cutting capacity of 200,000 feet per eight hour shift. The mill was operated during the war, but has been idle for some time. The property was owned by the David interests and included a smaller mill on an adjacent site, which was burned about a year ago. It is understood that repairs will be made immediately on the Monarch mill and operations will begin in about 60 days.
