

# POLITICS MIXED IN NORTH DAKOTA

 Fargo, N. D., Nov. 2.—North Dakota voters have a Chinese puzzle to solve in the polling booths next Tuesday.

While Non-Partisanship is the issue, the tickets are so mixed up voters will have a hard time telling whether they are voting for a Non-partisan or for an opponent of the league, unless they know their men.

Lynn J. Fraser, heading the Republican ticket for United States senator is a Non-partisan. J. F. T. O'Connor, Democrat, represents most of the forces opposed to the Townley organization.

R. A. Neston, present governor, is also on the Republican ticket for reelection. He was endorsed for reelection by the same convention that endorsed O'Connor, a Democrat, for senator.

There is only one congressional contest, and in this case J. H. Sinclair, congressman from the Third district, is a Non-partisan, but running as a Republican. His opponent is R. J. Hughes, Democrat, endorsed by the Independent Voters' association, an organization originally including all the Republicans who didn't like the Non-partisan league.

The Independent Voters' association also endorsed five Democrats for state office, along with four "regular" Republicans.

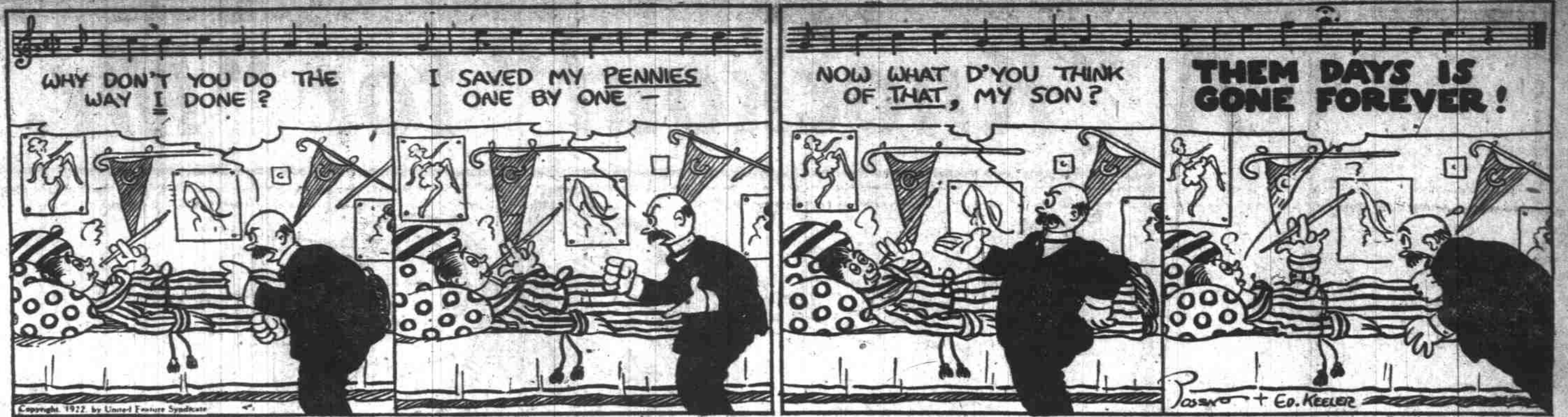
Seven of the Non-partisan candidates are filed as Republicans.

There seems to be a prevailing belief that former Governor Fraser will succeed Senator P. J. McCumber to the senate, whom he defeated for the Republican nomination in the primaries. Governor Neston probably will be re-elected, and J. H. Sinclair, Third district congressman, is expected to be returned.

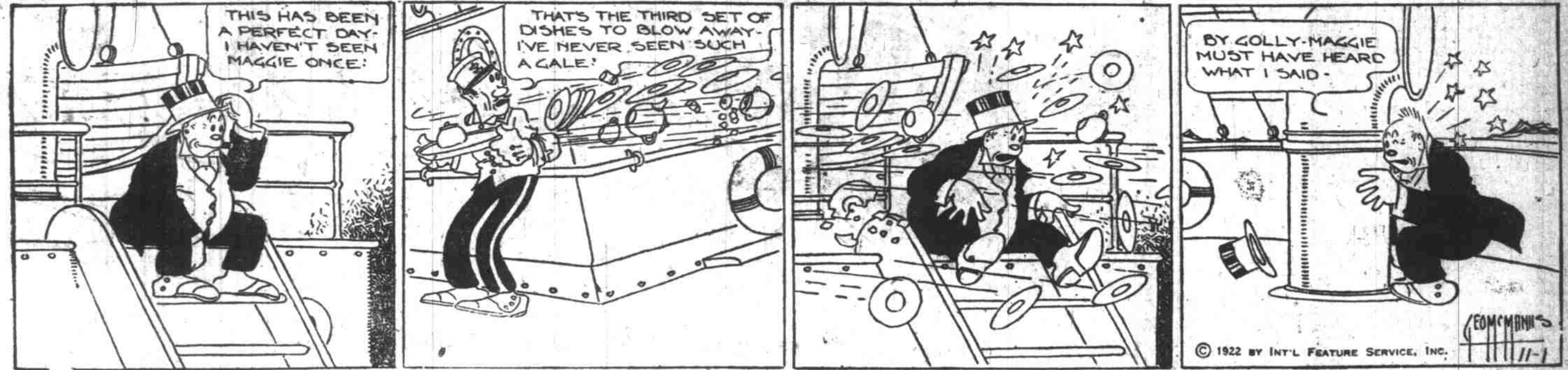
