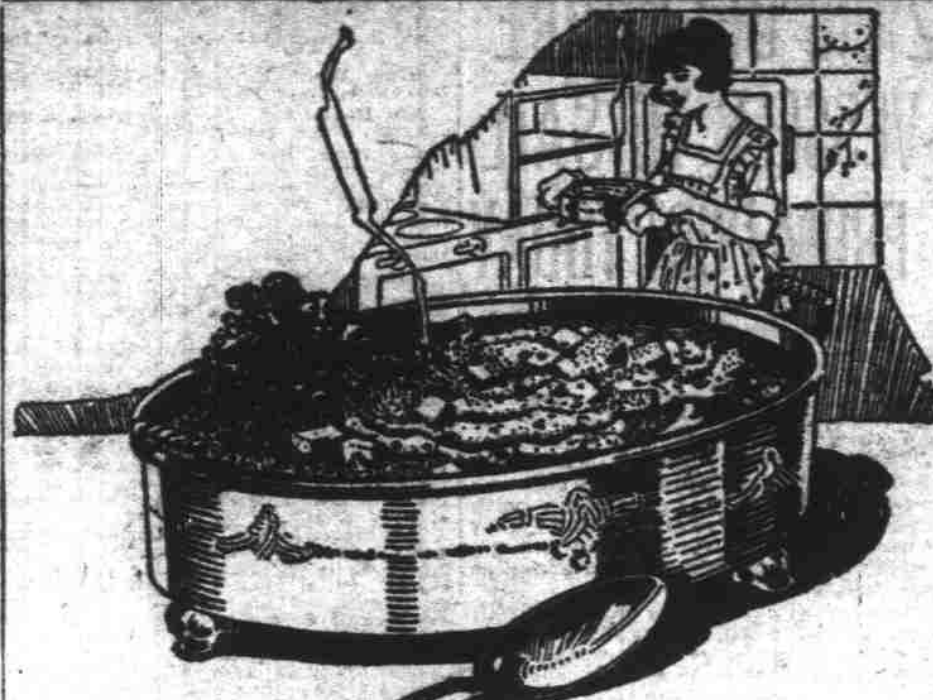


FARM TROUT A MARKET FEATURE

Real speckled trout are being offered on the Portland market. The fish are of the usual mountain variety and are about six to seven inches in length. They come from trout farms in Utah and arrived here in perfect condition. The business of fish farming is be-

coming quite well known in Oregon. There are several private farms in the state. They grow fish for the market and the specimens are usually even more attractive than the supplies that come from open waters. As the game fish becomes scarcer in the open waters the business of trout farming is expected to increase in this territory. Fresh fish continues very scarce. A small supply of King or Chinook salmon from Alaska is offering at 35c a pound and some local steels at 25c. Fresh halibut is still too scarce for more than a very few shops to have any supply. Prices therefore high. Sales and perch are in fair supply at usual prices and there is a limited stock of white sturgeon here. Red sturgeon, while tasting good, is not in demand here. FOR Saturday's dinner, potatoes au gratin made with Tillamook cheese. Use this recipe by Winifred Stuart Gibbs and "he" will forget his mother's cooking!

Potatoes au gratin

1. Make this white sauce, by melting 2 tablespoons butter, rub in 2 tablespoons flour, add 1 1/2 cups milk and 1/2 cup cream, bring to a boil and boil for 10 minutes, then stir in 1/2 cup Tillamook cheese fine and stir, bit by bit, into the hot sauce, being careful to melt each speck of cheese before adding more. Place 4 cups cold boiled potatoes, sliced, in buttered baking dish, pour the sauce over, and cover with 3/4 cup buttered cracker crumbs. Add a dash of paprika and bake in moderate oven until crumbs are well browned.
