A total of 38,000 Oregon school children were enrolled in the modern health crugade last year, the state being represented by all types and sizes chools from the tiny rural school to the big city school. This year, although the first semester is not yet closed, more than 15,000 children are snrolled. Here are the health chores to which the children must subscribe, if they would be classified as health crusaders: I washed my hands before each meal today. I washed my face, ears and neck and

fingers, pencils and everything unclean and injurious out of my mouth and I brushed my teeth thoroughly this morning and after the evening meal.

I drank four glasses of water, but no tea or coffee.

I was in bed 10 hours or more last night, and kept my window open.
I tried to eat slowly and only wholesome food, including milk, vegetables

I went to toilet at regular time. I tried to sit and stand erect. I tried hard to keep neat, to be cheerful, straight-forward and clean-minded,
