RANDOM VIEWS ALONG OREGON'S 60-MILLION-DOLLAR STATEWIDE HIGHWAY SYSTEM

W HERE natural nearty prevails: 1—Roman Heights on the Upper Columbia highway is traversed by a paved way of incomparable beauty. 2—Upward through the Hood River valley leads the Mount Hood Loop road, now under construction, that ultimately will encircle Oregon's premier peak. 3—Old Oregon Trail at the summit of Kamela Pass in the Blue mountains. 4—Columbia Gorge hotel on the supper highway. 5—Majestic vista of the Columbia with Wind mountain on the Washington side in the background. 6—Bandon beach in Southwestern Oregon skirted, by the Roosevelt Coast highway. 7—Picturesque Wallowa lake. 8—Mighty palisades on the John Day highway in Eastern Oregon. 9—Through the woods near the Pacific terminus of the Columbia River highway. Other major trunk highways include the Pacific highway, paved for the most part from the Columbia river to the California line.
