A PLAN FOR TEMPERANCE.

Mr. John Graham Brooks, recently connected with Harvard university, has contributed to the December number of the Forum a paper describing the workings of a singular scheme which has been used at Gothenburg and other towns in Sweden for the abatement and regulation of the liquor traffic.

But the chief aim has been to make the conditions such that no one would have a motive for pushing the sale of intoxicants any more than for making sales of food, tea or coffee.

The scheme has resulted in a partial success, in that the drinking of ardent spirits in Norway and Sweden has greatly decreased.

Mr. Brooks would like to see a similar experiment tried in small American towns where a pronounced sentiment in favor of temperance would insure the election of municipal officers who would not misuse their singular powers.
