The day came and the Dutchman wa called upon to speak.

"Shentlemans," said he rising, "I can neither make de speech nor sing de song,

but I vill deliver von grand poem."

This he proceeded relentlessly to do, and Halleck, when he heard his harmonious measures delivered in a mixture of English and Dutch, was divided between the temptation to laugh and cry.
