The day came and the Dutchman was called upon to speak.

"Shtetman," said he rising, "I can neither make do speech nor sing do song, but I will deliver you grand poem."

This he proceeded reluctantly to do, and Halleck, when he heard his harmonious measure delivered in a mixture of English and Dutch, was divided between the temptation to laugh and cry.
