Her majesty the empress is the patroness of the woman's department and the Moscow division is under the presidency of Grand Duchess Elizabeth, wife of Grand Duke Sergius, brother of the emperor.

The iron work for the observation tower, 290 feet in height, which is being built by Messrs. The iron parts are 54 feet in length, and the tower will be in five sections. The elevator will go up to a height of 250 feet.
