BIG LAKE STEAMERS.

Four New Boats Are Ordered by the Great Northern.

Since the recent visit to Cleveland, Ohio, of President Hill, of the Great Northern, to the Globe Iron works, where the two big twin-crew passenger steamers are being built for this line, it has been decided to build four more steamers of the type now under construction. The boats will cost \$600,000 each, and will develop 6,000 horse power. They will be 410 feet long, or 30 feet longer than the boats now under way. Work on the first of them will probably not be started until one of the steamers to come out next season has a trial. It is proposed to have a boat leave Buffalo almost daily for the head of lake Superior. It is said that there is some scheme for the control of transcontinental passenger traffic involved in the building of these boats.
