WHAT THE SHERMAN LAW IS.

As President Cleveland has called an extra session of congress to repeal the Sherman silver law, it is advisable for the people of the United States to look into this question and see what it is proposed to do. It is charged against the Sherman law that it is contracting the currency by driving gold to Europe. The enemies of silver say that the silver certificates are being presented at the sub-treasuries and are being paid in gold, which gold is then shipped to Europe, and that in order to pursue this policy it will be necessary to issue bonds to buy gold, and to avoid that it is proposed to repeal the Sherman law, providing for the monthly purchase of 4,500,000 ounces of silver. The Sherman law contains a clause which provides for the coinage of enough silver to redeem the silver certificates which shall be presented for payment, so there is no need of paying them in gold, and if the treasury department is redeeming them in gold they are doing an unlawful act as the language of the law admits of no other construction but to redeem the silver certificates in silver coin. But Senator Teller, of Colorado, proved during the last session of congress that they were not being paid in gold, by the written statement from the secretary of the treasury, who said that "silver certificates issued under the Sherman law were not in law or in practice, being redeemed in gold coin, nor had the treasury department authorized any of the sub-treasuries to do it." So it is necessary to look elsewhere for the cause of the export of gold and the cause is found in the fact that for more than a year the balance of trade has been largely against us, and the excess of imports over exports must be paid for in gold. But how the administration intends to better the situation by the policy it has openly announced is one of the mysteries of the world. The gold bugs say the error was in using silver as money in any amount. They say the silver dollar is responsible for all of our financial ills, but can they bear themselves out in that statement? In England when the Barings failed, the bank of England had to go to bimetallic France for ready money so as not to be seriously embarrassed by the Baring failure. That failure was not caused by debased silver currency, for England has no silver money to speak of. The recent heavy failures in Australia in which several hundred millions of dollars were swallowed up, was not caused by debased silver, as Australia is also on a gold basis.

We have a pamphlet before us which says that during the next six years nine-tenths of the human race will perish by war, plague, famine, pestilence, earthquake and hail, and reference is had to Rev. 16:21, Isa. 6:11-13, and Jer. 25:26-33. There is to be a great disruption among nations, see Rev. 2:27 and Ps. 2:9. The Jews are to become the ruling nation of the whole world for 1,000 years, commencing in 2,000, and the capital is to be at Jerusalem.

An inmate of the Oregon insane asylum thinks an egg represents gold and silver. He may not be so wrong after all. If the yolk represents the gold and the white the silver, then why is not the shell to represent the law? Thus an egg is a symbol of the financial question of today and the question is, How shall we place the law around the gold and silver so that they may be a unit?

Senator Squire favors the passage of a joint resolution authorizing Cleveland to suspend the silver-purchase clause of the Sherman act. As Cleveland suspended the Geary law without a joint resolution to back him, we do not see why it is necessary for such a resolution relative to the Sherman law. What is sauce for the Chinese is sauce for the silver men.

In the prosecution of the smuggling ring in Oregon and Washington, Secretary Carlisle is performing yeoman work, which every good citizen should appreciate. For years past the government has been defrauded millions of dollars, but the end has come.—Salem Statesman.

Penoyer's Opinion.

Governor Penoyer, on request, has sent the New York World the following on the financial situation: "The Sherman law, which degrades silver from its former position as a money metal to that of a mere commodity, should be repealed, while at the same time the use of both gold and silver as the standard money of the country without discriminating against either metal or charge for mintage as declared for in the last democratic national platform, should be secured. To repeal the Sherman law without restoring the silver dollar to its former function as full legal tender money would be no remedial legislation. It would be only making a bad matter worse. The tariff should be most materially reduced immediately and an income tax should be provided for, by which the wealth of the country would be compelled to help bear the burden of taxation."


