JIM LOTAN INDICTED. Arrested Yesterday and is Now Under Bonds.

R. G. PADDOCK IN THE TOILS. Both Charged with "Conspiracy to Defraud the Government" - Charles D. Cardinell Included.

PORTLAND, July 17.—James Lotan, ex-collector of customs of the port of Portland, gave himself up to the United States marshal at noon today.

Robert G. Paddock, deputy inspector of the customs service, was arrested before noon, on the same charge as preferred against Lotan.

The charges against both men are to the effect that they were engaged in a conspiracy against the government of the United States.

The grand jury during its short session of four active days, returned 21 indictments, all of which were true bills.

The first indictment placed in the hands of the marshal on which service was returned, was a joint indictment against William Dunbar and Nathan Blum.

The second count, referring to these same Chinamen, alleged that the defendants forged and counterfeited certain documents purporting to have been signed by certain citizens in Portland.

The third count alleges that a number of Chinamen were similarly landed here on January 27, and the fourth count alleges the forging and counterfeiting of certificates to effect their purpose.

The 21st day of September is the date of the next alleged illegal landing of Chinamen, with two counts of a similar purport as above.

Dunbar and Blum were found this morning without difficulty by the deputy marshals and immediately brought to the marshal's office to arrange about their bonds.

A CUT IN FARES. Union Pacific Has Boycotted the Great Northern.

ST. PAUL, July 17.—The passenger department of the Union Pacific has sent out circulars to its local officers in this city, declaring a boycott against the Great Northern.

The Northern Pacific, via its Chicago connection, the Western Central, has made a one-fare rate from points in Minnesota and North Dakota.

HELENA, Mont., July 16.—The closing down of the silver mines at Granite and Philipsburg, where the Granite Mountain and Bimetallic mines, the two greatest silver producers in the state are located.

When the mines first closed, the miners made a run upon the banks. Many of them were paid their money, but one of Philipsburg's banks, thoroughly solvent but without ready cash enough to meet an immediate settlement.
