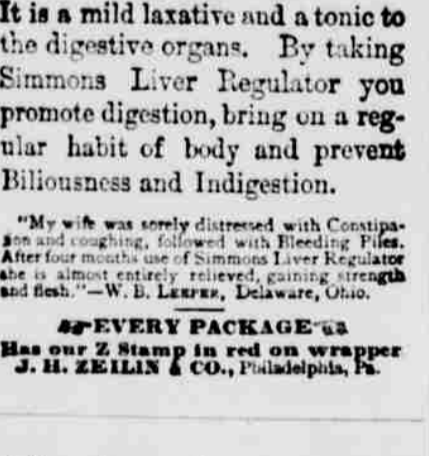

DEATH IN THE FLAMES. Early Morning Blaze in a Chicago Hotel. FIVE KILLED AND MANY INJURED. Over a Million Gone Up in Smoke in Minneapolis—Hundreds of People Homeless.

CHICAGO, Aug. 14.—A hotel fire resulting in the death of a number of the guests occurred this morning in a three-story structure on Madison street, near Fifth avenue. A man jumped from the top story of the building and was killed, and about half a dozen others were suffocated and burned to death.

THE MONEY QUESTION. Bill Authorizing Another Issue of National Bank Notes. OTHER LEGISLATION INTRODUCED. Senator Hill's Objection—The Situation Is Already Improved, and \$20,000,000 More is Coming.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 14.—In the senate, Voorhees introduced a bill authorizing an issue of national bank notes of the full value of bonds deposited.

Numerous petitions on the silver question were presented and referred, and one for the annexation of the Hawaiian islands, the latter coming from the San Francisco chamber of commerce.

Senator Palmer, of Illinois, introduced a bill to provide for the erection of a government building at Chicago on the present postoffice site, to be finished in 18 months, to cost \$4,000,000.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 14.—In the house, after the appointment of a committee on enrolled bills, the silver debate was resumed. Boatsner, democrat, of Louisiana, spoke in favor of free coinage.
