Train Accident at Hood River.

A dispatch from Hood River to the Telegram says:

The Union Pacific morning freight train was delayed three hours 1/2 miles east of here this morning by a landslide. The engine ran into the slide and three trainmen were injured by jumping. These were Joseph Wilson, fireman, right hand and leg cut and face scratched; John Christians, engineer, leg sprained; Glendenning, conductor, bruised about the legs. The engine was not derailed, and the engineer shutting off the steam before jumping, the train was brought to a stop without any serious damage except that the engine was slightly disabled.
