THE NICARAGUA CANAL.

The bill providing for the final construction of the Nicaragua canal will probably pass congress at this session.

The exploration of the route was made by Commodore Lull, and is said to show a practicable route, with lake Nicaragua as its summit level, 107 feet above the sea.

One of the principal difficulties will be in maintaining a sufficient depth of water at Greytown, the Atlantic terminus of the canal.
