To Build Homes for Indians.

PENDLETON, Or., Jan 10 .- The Indian department at Washington is considering a proposition to devote \$100,000 to improve the homes of the Indians of the Umatilla reservation. Agent Harper in his annual report to the secretary of the interior showed that the Indians were not self-supporting. The secretary sent for information and opinions as to how to make them more independent. Harper recommended that money to the extent of \$100,000 from the sale of lands now on deposit to the Indians' credit at Washington be appropriated to build homes. In case it is done, all the houses will probably be built under one contract.
