A state Census.
The constitution of Oregon provide that an enumeration of the people of the tate shall be made every ten yeare, be
ginning with 1865 . The statates furthe provide that this enumeration shall be made by the county assessors, beginning not later than May 10 th, and that besides enumerating the people of the
state, they shall classify them by age and sex and collect varions simple The aseessors are to make returns to the County clerks, and these to the secretary
of state, who is to furnish blank form for the enumeration and declare the re sult. Penalties are imposed upon
