### The Removal of Governor Hughes.

PHOENIX, A. T., March 9.—The long-looked-for removal of Governor Hughes today assumed the semblance of reality. This morning a telegram was received from Secretary Wilson by E. F. Kellner, in which Kellner was asked if he would accept the governorship. Kellner is a wealthy and prominent merchant, the president of the chamber of commerce, and a strong democrat. He is not identified with any of the warring democratic members of the legislature. It is understood he has signified his willingness to accept by telegraph.
