Bluefields Now Considered a Part of Nicaraguan Territory.

New York, March 11.—General Barrios, Nicaragua's minister to Great Britain, who arrived on the Umbria from England, refused to speak today regarding the Bluefields trouble, which his government sent him to adjust with the British government, further than to say his errand was successful, and Bluefields is now considered a portion of Nicaraguan territory. Barrios added that his visit here has no political significance whatever.
