TOWARDS ANARCHY.

Yesterday United States Judge Gilbert appointed John M. Egan receiver of the Oregon Short Line. The appointment is ill-timed, and will serve to atrengthen the idea already unfortunately too prevalent, that the United States courts will do almost anything that railroads want them to. For Judge Gilbert we have the profoundest respect. We look upon him as being both an ideal man and an ideal judge; and yet the fact remains that the appointment is an unfortunate one. Line another man addressed a large audience in Portland on the subject of the railroad strikes in Chicago last July. That man was Eugene V. Debs, the president of the American Railway Union.
