DONSON, April 18.—The statement that the foreign office declines to accept the reply of Nicaragua to the British ultimatum is made upon official authority. The discrepancy between this announcement and the statement made last Saturday that the reply was satisfactory that the government had abandoned its threatened action against Nicaragua is explained by the fact that the decision of the foreign office last week has been revised after consultation between Lord Rosebery and Lord Kimberley concerning later communications from Nicaragua.


