WASHINGTON, July 31 .- Reports reseived at the office of the chief of engineers indicate that satisfactory progress is being made in the fortifications harbor of San Francisco. Among the works which are expected to be completed during the year is the construction of emplacements for two 12-inch guns on non-disappearing carriages.
