Sherman County Items.

EDITOR CHRONICLE—Rev. Geo. Morehead preached his farewell sermon in the Presbyterian church at Moro last Sunday, and left for Antelope Monday, presumably for the purpose of being married to Mrs. Lavica Doherty. The ceremony was to have been performed by Rev. Motor, presiding elder, who was to have come from Arlington especially for the occasion. R. J. and Mrs. Ginn and E. Peoples also went to Antelope Monday to witness the ceremony. Everyone cordially wishes Rev. Morehead and bride a long and prosperous wedded life.

An assault and battery case came up before Justice Meader at Moro last Tuesday, which caused some sensation. It was the case of State of Oregon vs. A. Scott. The defendant called for a jury trial, but it availed him not, for the verdict was guilty. The evidence showed that the defendant received considerable provocation from the prosecuting witness before committing the battery complained of, and in view of the mitigating circumstances, his honor imposed a fine of \$10, which the defendant paid, and went his way (not rejoicing, however).

Mr. Alverson, who has property interests in Sherman county, accompanied by a lawyer from Seattle, was at the county seat Monday on business.

A lecturer, accompanied by his wife, visited Moro last week and addressed the people on the growth of Roman in the United States. If he had been more temperate in his utterances, he would have made a deeper impression upon his audience. He intangled abuse with argument, and injected poison and bitterness into most of his remarks, so that many who were favorably inclined towards the organization before they heard him left the hall somewhat dissatisfied with the man, if not with the principles he advocated. 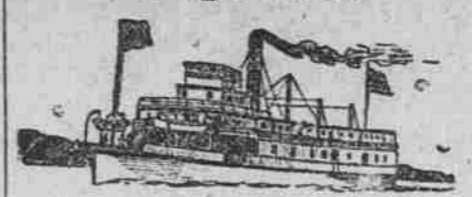
