Fatrhaver, Wash., Oct. 26.-A terrific explosion occurred at the Pacific
Coast Mlling company's lumber mill at $5: 10$ this morning, killing two men,
fatally wounding another and severely injuring three more, as well as wrecking the mill property.

being blown fully 500 feet, pasing hrough the dryhouse and drooping hrough the railroad trestle into the water. The boiler-house is a totrl wreck he main portion of the mill and outbuildngs are badly shattered and th debris.
There were seven men at work in the aill at the time of the explosion. 0 hese Armatrong, the fireman, and $J$ killed outright. G. W. Newkirk, the econd fireman, was so terribly bruised and scalded that the physician has no Whatcom, was badly injured, but wil and A. T.
