Sau Francisco Call. Oct. 25. Two suits were filed in the United States circuit court on the 23d inst. by the Western Electric Company of Chicago, against the Capital Telephone Company of Sacramento, with which corporation Frederick Cox, president of the California Bank of Sacramento, and W. E. Gerber, also of the California

bank, are associated as defendants. One of the suits filed is for the infringements of patents on switchboard apparatus and office machinery, which are held by the Chicago corporation, and the other on the telephones and manner of wiring. The patents held by the regular telephone company and the Western Electric Company cover every conceivable part of the sound transmitter, thereby making it almost impossible for a new concern to successfully operate a telephone circuit.
