

AFTER AMERICAN FISHERMEN.

Their Nets Were Spread on Canada's Side of Lake Erle.

SANDUSKY, O., Nov. 5 .- The Canadian government is again after American fishermen. The revenue cruiser Petrel, in command of Captain Dann, seized a large amount of nets and fish belonging to Sandusky fisherman. Fifteen steamers and several men were engaged in fishing out of this port, and in the morning the vessels left for the fishing grounds.
