This in view of the passage through the Dardanelles of the British gunboat Dryad and the Italian gunboat Archimeade, as extra guardships for the British and Italian embassies, formed the basis for a report that the rioung predieted by the Yildiz Kiosk courtiers had actually commenced, but happily the trouble was not serious, although the Armenians, as usual, are accused of having attempted to bring about an uprising.
