Chief Justice Zane Administered the Oath of Office to Governor Wells and Other Officials-Governor's Address.

SALT LAKE, Jan. 6 .- Another state has been added to the American Union, and the rights of self-government have been extended to a quarter of a million of industrious, law-abidin; and intelligent people. The acquisition of these longsought rights causes universal joy among all classes.

The oath of office was administered to the state officials of Utah at noon today, and the new state, with her vast mineral wealth, great railway systems, agricultural resources, churches and institutions of learning, starts off with the promise of a bright and glorious future. Among those who took part in the ceremonies were many of the old pioneers of 1857, who faced the privations and dangers of frontier life to lay the foundation of this great common-wealth.

The city was crowded with people from all parts of the state. Acting-Governor Richards had, by proclamation, declared the day a holiday. All business was suspended and the buildings along the principal streets were decorated with the national colors. The day was ushered in by the ringing of bells and the sounding of all the steam whistles in the
