Mr. V. C. Brock, cashier of the Sher-man county bank at Wasco, is in the city today. He is accompanied by his wife.


Messrs. T. W. Glavey, James Baxter, John Bolton and W. S. Hendrix make np a delegation of Kingsley residents who are in the city today.
