HE SAYS PITZEL IS STILL ALIVE

OTHER REPORTED VICTIMS ALIVE

He Claims to Have Full Proof of His Assertions - Nannie Williams Was Killed by Her

The Pitzel murder case is now pending in the supreme court of Pennsylvania, and will come up for a hearing within a few days, and the defense is making a determined effort to secure the reversal of the finding of the jury and lower court on technical grounds. If these fail, then the information gathered by the defense will be restored to, and it is expected that they will be able to prove beyond a doubt that the alleged victim, Benjamın Pitzel, is alive and living within a radius of 100 miles of the city of Chicago, at the present time.


